Annie's Project Vision

The Advisory Committee

The Advisory Committee will be a collection of individuals who bring unique knowledge and skills which augment the knowledge and skills of the Annie's Project Board of Directors in order to more effectively guide the organization. The Advisory Committee does not have formal authority to govern Annie's Project, the advisory committee serves to make recommendations, provide advice, and/or provide key information and materials to the Board. The Advisory Committee members: may assist with public relations; may provide program staff with a fresh perspective on programmatic issues; may work on fund development activities in conjunction with the Board and staff.

- Two year term with the opportunity of one additional term. Up to four years contiguous. May reapply after two years of being off the committee.
- Each Advisory Committee member serves on one Annie's Project Committee along with Board of Directors members, and any other volunteers that may be appointed to said committee. Committees include: Curriculum, Facilitator Training and Support, Marketing and Resource Development (fundraising).
- Advisory Committee of the whole meets at least quarterly. Annie's Project Committees meet at least every other month.
- Up to 15 members will be appointed to these national volunteer committee positions.
- Advisory Committee members will have the opportunity to participate in a new leadership development program.

Minimum time commitment includes regular quarterly advisory committee meetings and Annie's Project committee meetings in every other month. Committee project work. Leadership and Advisory Committee development activities. Preparation time for meetings. Total Minimum Annual Commitment 60 hours

- A letter of application detailing the candidate's interest; other information on talents and experiences that are not detailed on their resume/CV; and any previous involvement in Annie's project.
- Applicants should also indicate which committee(s) that they are interested in serving on and provide evidence of skills that would relate to the committee. It would be helpful if a ranking of committee preferences could be provided. Committees include – Curriculum, Facilitator Training and Support, Marketing and Resource Development (fundraising)
